 - Identifying needs of vulnerable populations in disasters
- 2. Provider services
 - Communicating with providers
 - Provider perceptions or biases
 - Provider availability
- 3. Emergency management and disaster services
 - Evacuation and relocation services
 - Sheltering services/FAST teams
 - Communication between partners during disasters/agency collaboration
 - Specific populations elderly, LGBTQ+, homeless, migrants, multi-generational households
 - Rural populations having access to services
 - Public information and education
 - Post disaster recovery
 - Location of shelters, points of distribution, family assistance centers, disaster resource centers, other
- Community infrastructure and functioning
 - Community health risks
 - Community natural disaster hazards
 - Socioeconomic health of the community
 - Available health education
 - Community social values and biases
