- You must be a person with a disability.
- You must be willing to activate your phone and service online with your real information.
- You must be willing to register for the online medical service with your real information.
- You must participate in before and after interviews via Zoom.
- You must participate in weekly assignments and complete an online questionnaire after each assignment.
- You must live in one of the following states to be eligible:
