One of our projects is about disability Inclusive emergency drills. about disability Inclusive emergency drills are practical field exercises primarily aimed at the entire community, with special consideration given to the participation of people with disabilities, their organizations, and families. Inclusive emergency drills for disability involve the mobilization and deployment of human, material, and equipment resources, among others, to enable the training and coordination of the response from authorities, the general population, people with disabilities, and other institutions on how to inclusively respond to emergencies and disasters. This is achieved by establishing a fictional scenario that recreates a hypothetical emergency, disaster, or catastrophe situation, based on a specific risk variable that could potentially affect a territory. These drills test specific emergency plans as well as the roles and functions of the agencies supporting the emergency response process, incorporating the disability variable into each component of the process.
