Disability-Owned Business Resources

Business Associations: membership organizations that are engaged in and support the business interests of their members. An example is a Chamber of Commerce - U.S. Chamber of Commerce <u>https://www.uschamber.com</u>

Business Incubator Program: an organization that helps startup companies and individual entrepreneurs to develop their businesses

Community Development Financial Institution (CDFI): provide financial services in low-income communities and to people who lack access to financing. <u>https://synergieswork.org/</u>

Achieving a Better Life Experience (ABLE) Accounts: a special savings account that allows people with disabilities save up to \$100,000 and not be considered a resource. Therefore, the savings will not impact SSI, Medicaid, food stamps (SNAP), or other benefits. <u>https://www.ablenrc.org/</u>

Plan for Achieving Self-Support (PASS): allows people receiving SSI to set aside income or resources to achieve a specific work goal without affecting benefits or be considered resources. <u>https://www.ssa.gov/disabilityresearch/wi/pass.htm</u>

Individual Development Account (IDA): a savings account in which your deposits are "matched" at a certain rate. IDAs are usually used to save for school, purchasing a home, or starting a business. <u>https://prosperitynow.org/map/idas</u>

Vocational Rehabilitation (VR) /Rehabilitation Services Administration (RSA): a state program that provides a variety of services to persons with disabilities, with the ultimate goal to prepare for, enter into, or retain employment. <u>https://rsa.ed.gov/about/states</u>
